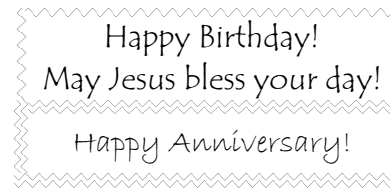
Our Prayers for Praise and Petition
